

AIHEC CONFERENCE 2005 One Act Theater Competition



OVERVIEW

This event allows tribal college students the opportunity to share their dramatic talent. Students can use a published or original piece for their presentation.

Guidelines

1. The performance can be from 15 – 20 minutes.
2. A minimum of 4 actors must be in the scene. There is no maximum limit of actors allowed.
3. All performers must be enrolled for at least 9 credits at a tribal college and be in good academic standing.
4. A panel will review the performance and give a critique to each group.
5. Each acting troupe will be responsible for all of their props, set items, etc. Each group will have five minutes at the beginning and five minutes at the end to take care of props and stage issues. For this reason, all groups need to plan carefully.
6. Any special equipment and/or sound item are the responsibility of the acting troupe.
7. Time limits are strictly enforced. Groups going over the limit will be stopped and asked to leave the stage.
8. Costumes are encouraged.
9. No scripts will be allowed. Actors are to memorize all lines.
