Rules

1. Create the web page using notepad and HTML.
2. All web pages will be entered on a CD.
3. Participants can use, sound, music, photos, etc.
4. Use materials that are not copy protected.
5. No more than five pages.

Equipment

1. 17" Monitors with 1024 by 768 pixels display settings
2. Internet Explorer Browser
3. CD drive
4. Legacy video capture device, legacy audio drivers, media control device, and speakers.

Judging

1. Appropriate use of web features-20%
2. Level of code-20%
3. Creativity-20%
4. Design-20%
5. Display-20%

A panel of four judges will view the web pages. The judges will have ten minutes to view the web page and the html document. How easy is your document to read?

Each item is judged from 0 through 20%. The items are totaled to come up with the total score. Each judge previews each web page individually not as a group.
