Admissions Requirements

New Applicants (application fee: \$5.00)

- Unofficial Transcripts: high school or GED transcript **or** Official College transcripts of less than 24 credit hours.
- Standardized Exams: ACT, SAT, ACCESS, COMPASS or ACCUPLACER.
- **Required after mid-terms during the students second semester:**
 - Two Letters of Recommendation: At least one should be from a teacher, counselor, or community leader.
 - Statement of Interest: One page typed, 12 point font, addressing the following:
 1. Describe your educational and life goals and how IAIA can help you fulfill them.
 2. Describe an example of a leadership role you held in your community.
 3. Describe a situation in which you had to overcome adversity.
 - Portfolio in the area of intended study. Please contact the Admissions Office for instruction or see Portfolio Requirements below.

College Transfer Applicants (application fee: \$5.00)

- Official Transcripts from Accredited College(s).
- Two Letters of Recommendation: At least one should be from a teacher, counselor, or community leader
- Statement of Interest (same as above)
- Portfolio: Required for college transfer applicants with 24 or more credit hours.

For Studio Arts: The portfolio must contain a minimum of 10 art pieces, related to the applicant's intended major and created within the past two years. Slides must be labeled with the applicant's name, date of work, slide number, and slide key. The slides must be placed in plastic viewing sleeves.

Electronic media may include digital images of artwork. Files may be sent on CDs DVDs and must be labeled. Applicants may also email their files to the Admissions Director. The student may submit original two-dimensional pieces, such as drawings, illustrations, design projects, photographs, or watercolors each identified by name and date on the back—as long as the container in which it is submitted is large and rigid enough to protect the work in transit.

For New Media Arts: Submit a review of the student's work from NMAR112; and a 500 word minimum essay on why they wish to join the department.

*Moving Image majors are also required to provide a short film demonstrating ability and desire to the Moving Images track.

For Creative Writing: Submit 15 to 20 pages of original work (poetry, fiction, playwriting, or nonfiction).

For Museum Studies: Please submit a statement of interest in the Museum Studies program of no less than 200 words. The statement should include:

- your greatest academic strengths and weaknesses
- your current knowledge of the museum/cultural center field
- the kinds of experiences you hope will be a part of your college education
- your reasons for choosing the Museum Studies degree program

For Indigenous Liberal Studies: 1,000 word essay including:

- What you expect to gain through the participation of the Indigenous Liberal Studies Program/Native American Studies program
- What experience you have had as a member of/or working for an Indian community
- What issues facing the Indigenous community seem most important to you
- in the following format; slides, photographs, or electronic media. Original artwork only as a last option (IAIA is not responsible for loss or damages.)

Readmission Applicants (application fee: \$5.00) Students who are within 3 semesters of last IAIA attendance date.

- Statement of Interest (same as above)
