This position will also educate faculty in the best practices of computer-based/distance learning education technology.

Required: Bachelor's degree in Instructional Technology or related field to distance learning or computer based education. Must have a minimum of five yrs management/leadership experience in Education Technology coordinating college level/secondary level online education, including experience managing a budget, conducting project meetings, providing training in educational technology, delivering distance learning program objectives, collaborating effectively, collecting and compiling information and preparing reports.
